***8 week program: March 2-April 25***

This class explores the basics of drawing, painting, coloring and printing. Students develop art skills with the creative use of pastels, water colors, acrylics and more. Level I is an introductory class for children ages 6-9. Level II is comprised of students who have completed Level I or have had previous instruction in drawing and are ready for more advanced projects. Instructor: Lyudmila Antonyuk

*Ceramics I (Ages 5 ½ – 8) Wednesday 3:00-4:00pm*

*Ceramics II (Ages 9 – Adult) Wednesday 4:00-5:00pm*

***8 week program: March 2-April 25***

Instruction in clay molding to build original sculptures and the use of pre-made ceramic pieces, both utilized to explore printing, underglazing and dipping techniques to create finished ceramic pieces. Instructor: Lyudmila Antonyuk

*Pottery for Tweens and Teens (Ages 10+) Tues. 4:30-6:00pm*

*Wednesday 5:30-7:00pm Thursday 4:30-6:00pm*

***8 week program: March 2-April 25***

Classes offer instruction in basic handbuilding techniques through use of pinch, coil, slabs, drape molds, and may include introduction to wheel throwing for more advanced students. White earthenware clay, lowfire glaze materials, and kiln firings are provided, with additional supplies available for a fee. Sessions incorporate student ideas, seasonal themes, and include demonstrations as needed.

Instructor: **Tammy Hynes** has a Bachelors Degree in Architecture and Design from the University of Florida. She has studied and taught pottery in the Charlotte area for over five years. She brings her passion for pottery to our studio with creative and exciting project ideas!

*Clay and Beyond: (Ages 16+)*

*All levels welcome Th 7:00-9:00pm*

***8 week program: March 2-April 25***

This class offers basic to advanced instruction of pottery forms through the use of an electric wheel. The students use white earthenware clay and appropriate glazes for low fire temperature in an electric kiln. Hand builders are welcome and open studio times are included for extra practice. Instructor works with students to explore their interests, personal goals, and ideas.

Instructor: **Verna Witt** has been working with pottery for many years and enjoys showing her passion for pottery and design work with new potters.
